Scarborough Centre for Healthy Communities (SCHC)

Established in 1977, **SCHC** is an accredited comprehensive community health organization that delivers a range of holistic health and wellness services from early years to the end-of-life.

For half a century, we have been serving vulnerable residents – newcomers, visible minorities, families living with poverty, homelessness, and unemployment -across Scarborough who experience many barriers to access needed support. We are dedicated to meeting these health needs by addressing our population's physical, mental, social, financial and environmental aspects through our community health, engagement and support services teams. SCHC employs over 300 staff, engages more than 160 volunteers, and delivers over 50 integrated services across 12 sites.

SCHC offers many programs for youth, ages 13-29, that address their health, emotional wellbeing and social support. We aim to create a safe and welcoming space for youth to develop practical life skills, emotional intelligence, positive decision-making, empower them to become active leaders and change-makers within their communities.

Last year, SCHC served close to **4,600 children and youth** through its various programs and services.

Many youth in our catchment face barriers in accessing affordable, safe, and meaningful opportunities outside of school. Financial constraints, social isolation, mental health challenges, and limited access to leadership development and skill-building programs reduce opportunities for connection and growth.

SCHC's YLP helps bridge the gaps by providing free, welcoming and safer spaces where youth can build confidence, develop life skills, foster positive relationships, and realize their potential along with strengthen their connection to the community.

Equally important, these youth leaders effect positive change in the community by mentoring younger program members, supporting primary school children academically, and initiating community improvement projects.

While SCHC YLP initiatives engage more than 100 youth each year, the overall impact on the community is unbound through time.
